"Ba Zi" Analysis: Four Pillars of the Destiny

Data:

John F. Kennedy

Born on: 05/29/1917

Selection of the SOLAR Chinese Calendar, which is not important here, since the Solar Month is the same as the Lunar Month.

Date of the Analysis: 10/30/2007

Preliminary Remark:

In the present document, we are studying a Natal Chart with the techniques of the **Ba Zi** Chinese Astrology, also called **Eight Words** or **Four Pillars of the Destiny**, or even **Zi Ping** from the name of one of its well-known specialists.

Some basic notions on the Chinese Calendar:

There are **ten Heavenly Stems**: *Jia, Yi, Bing, Ding, Wu, Ji, Geng, Xin, Ren* and *Gui*. Five are of Yin polarity, five are Yang.

And there are **twelve Earthly Branches** (which are the famous **animals** of the Chinese Zodiac): *Zi* (Rat), *Chou* (Buffalo or Ox), *Yin* (Tiger), *Mao* (Cat or Rabbit), *Chen* (Dragon), *Si* (Snake), *Wu* (Horse), *Wei* (Goat), *Shen* (Monkey), *You* (Rooster), *Xu* (Dog) and *Hai* (Boar or Pig). Six are Yin, six are Yang.

If we build couples with the elements of these two series, we get one hundred and twenty couples, or binomials. If we just keep those having only Yin elements or only Yang elements, we have 60 binomials: here is the famous Chinese Sexagesimal Cycle, known by heart by every Chinese astrologer: **Jia-Zi, Yi-Chou, Bing-Yin, Ding-Mao...**

In a Chinese Date, there are **Four "Pillars"**: one for the Year, one for the Month, one for the Day and one for the Hour.

All these Pillars are one of the sixty possible binomials. And is thus a combination of 2 elements or "words", that is **Eight Words** at the end.

Each Year is thus part of a cycle of 60 Years, which begins with the #1 binomial, **Jia-Zi** (for instance, 1984 is a **Jia-Zi** year).

Inside a given Year, each of the twelve Months is associated with one of the 60 binomials: the cycle starts again every five years ($12 \times 5 = 60$).

Same thing for each Day of the Year: the cycle is used six times a year, and, each Year, we have six days having the same binomial as our birth day. These are six **special** days, known to present the same energetic potential as our birthday. **Your** special days for the current year are listed at the end of this document.

Notion of Hidden Stems

Each Branch is associated with one or several of the ten Heavenly Stems, which bring their own meaning.

For instance, the Branch of the Dragon (**Chen**) which is "Yang-Earth", is associated with the Hidden Stems **Wu**, **Yi** and **Gui**, which bring the connotation "Yang Earth", "Yin Wood" and "Yin Water".

A Simplistic Analysis...

Note: in this document, please read *he* or *she* or *s/he* instead of *he*.

The simplest method is based on the sole Birth Year. This often gives some pieces of information but remains very vague since all the persons born on the same year would have the same characteristics.

Your Chinese animal is the Snake.

Attractive, smart, hating vulgarity, sometimes narcissistic, the Snake has a disconcerting manner. Reserved, passive, he is a solitary person, but he fascinates. Elusive, he prefers to get round obstacles. Remarkably keeping his composure, he is materialistic, very perceptive (sometimes visionary) and makes an excellent organizer. He is also a generous, emotional, in fact fragile person, who can prove to be very devoted, in spite of his apparent reserve. He often seems lazy, until he understands his real goal in life.

Hereafter is what can be said concerning your Birth Year Binomial:

This couple Branch-Stem is the Binomial N° 54: Ding-Si or Fire Snake.

It is associated with the sound N° 27, Earth of the sands of the desert.

Some call it the Snake of the pond.

It characterizes the chinese years Ding-Si or Snake of DINH in Vietnamese, for instance 1857, 1917, 1977, 2037...

Attractive, materialistic, energetic, possessive and not very intuitive, the Fire Snake has a liking for power, and above all for money.

But in spite of a certain willpower, he dreads having to make an effort, both physical and intellectual, and he prefers to give free rein to his torrid sensuality.

He finds it very difficult to remain faithful.

This Binomial (54) is said to be strong.



There are other methods which only examine the Birth Year. For instance, you can read, at the end of the present document, the analysis of the Annual Number (**9 Star Ki** Astrology). A more complete method, based on the **numerological** Analysis of the Birth Date is also provided.

However, the most interesting Pillar is the Day Pillar (also called **Day Master**). Its Heavenly Stem indicates the true personality of the person. For instance, if the stem of your Day Master is **Jia** or **Yi**, you are Wood, if the stem is **Bing** or **Ding**, you are Fire etc...

The strength of this element must then be analyzed. And its equilibrium as well: how this element is supported, attacked, generated....

Before beginning this important analysis, let's examine the Yin-Yang balance of this chart.

Yin-Yang Analysis:

Yin and **Yang** are polarities:

- **Yin** symbolizes night, mystery, gestation, nourishing earth, stillness, lower parts, North, cold, women, unconscious.
- **Yang** symbolizes day, light, brightness, sun, movement, upper parts, South, heat, energy, men, concrete.

Women can have a **Yang** polarity, they will then be determined, masculine and extroverted women.

Yin men are more gentle, artistic, imaginative and introverted.

Half of the 12 Earthly Branches (or animals) are Yin, the other half being Yang. The same is true of the 10 Heavenly Stems.

The **Yin** appears 6 times over 8: you are **Very Yin**.

If we take into account the notion of the Stems which are hidden inside the Branches, we obtain the following result: 11 Yang /20 ==>Very Yang.

Analysis of the Natal Element (the element of the Heavenly Stem of the Day Master)

The strength of the Stem of the Master Day depends on the season of the birth, on the support from the stems and hidden stems of the different pillars, on the harmony between these branches...

Your Element is **METAL**. This Natal Element is **Weak** .

We'll see further what can be said on this strength or weakness of the Natal Element.

Metal evokes chastity, will, harshness and integrity. You are determined to follow through your undertakings, no obstacle can stop you, on the contrary difficulties motivate you. You know perfectly well how to manage on your own, and find people asking for advice hard to take.



Your objectives are concrete and well-defined: you are wary of what could reassess your material life. Rigid, determined, you lack of diplomacy, you break off and decide. You give sound advice.

Your strength can reassure some but you are not very easy-going, for you smother the personality of those around you with your strictness and your intolerance. Learn how to be less straight, how to accept others' differences.

Positive sides: Impartiality, justice, loyalty, honesty, heroism, responsibility, firmness, decisiveness.

Negative sides, if Metal is in a difficult position: acerbic mind, miserliness, cruelty, indecision, useless bravery.

Analysis of the Day Master with the help of the other stems.

Evaluating the four pillars of a chart consists in weighing the Day Master, i.e. the stem of the day pillar. The remaining of the chart corresponds to the different parts of the scales you will use for that: the pivot, the pans, the weights...

The Six Relations and the Ten Aspects:

If we compare the Heavenly Stem of each Pillar (the hidden stems included) with the Stem of the Master Day, which symbolizes ME, the owner of this chart, we obtain 5 cases, called the Relations, depending on the elements of the 2 stems:

- **Fellows:** symbolized by MY element.
If, for instance, the stem of the Master Day is Fire, then my Fellows are symbolized by the Fire. They represent helps, supports, benefactors, brothers and sisters but also colleagues and rivals: it's thus not always positive.
- **Productions:** this relation is symbolized by the element that I generate.
In our example, the Fire generates the Earth: Productions are thus symbolized by Earth.
Productions firstly represent intelligence. And we know that too much intelligence may be as difficult to manage as too little. Productions also represent the children.
- **Money:** symbolized by the element I control.
In our example, as the Fire controls Metal, wealth is represented by Metal. This relation also represents the subordinates and the wife.
- **Power:** represented by the element that controls ME.
In our example, Water controls Fire, the Power is thus associated with Water.
A chart with too much power often describes problems due to a too strong authoritarianism. This relation also indicates the authority we go through: boss, government, husband....
- **Potential:** it's what generates ME. The element generating the stem of the Master Day.
In our example, the Potential will be symbolized by the Wood, which generates the Fire.
An unbalanced chart with too much Potential is often an indication of wasted talents. Potential corresponds to the parents and the faithful friends but also to the disciples, followers, fans, supporters of any kind...



If we include the Day Master itself, we have thus **Six Relations**.

With the following inter-relations:

- **Fellows** generates **Productions** which generates **Money** which generates **Power** which generates **Potential** which generates **Fellows**.
- **Fellows** controls **Money** which controls **Potential** which controls **Productions** which controls **Power** which controls **Fellows**.
- **Fellows** is weakened by **Productions** which is weakened by **Money** which is weakened by **Power** which is weakened by **Potential** which is weakened by **Fellows**.

As you are METAL, here is the meaning of each element:

More information on the strength of your Natal Element:

We have seen above that your Natal Element is **METAL** and that this element is **Weak** .

This weakness may have several reasons:

? On the Birth date, the Natal Element is in a bad status.

==>The Birth Month, in this chart, is Favourable to the element METAL.

? This Element is drained by too much Productions.

==>This is not the case.

? It is controlled by too much Power.

==>This is the case.

? It is weakened by the need to control too much Money.

==>This is not the case.



There is thus a lot of Power.

We can thus consider that the main element of this chart is EARTH which symbolizes the Potential and which strenghtens the natal element, thus balancing the chart.

Let us remark that the status of this element is Very Favourable.

The Ten Aspects Table...

Function of the polarity (Yin-Yin ou Yin-Yang) of the Stems, we get **Ten Aspects**:

- **Fellows** becomes **Reinforcement** or *Dissension*.
- **Production** becomes *Main Productions* or *Anarchistic Productions*.
- **Money** becomes *Main Money* or *Secondary Money*.
- **Power** becomes *Main Power* or *Secondary Power*.
- **Potential** becomes *Main Potential* or *Secondary Potential*.

Ten Aspects Analysis

0 MAIN PRODUCTION

Productions allow to evaluate the skills of a Person.

In the Cycle of Elements, Productions create Money and soften the Power with some wisdom. Main Production also symbolizes optimism, idealism and longevity.

No Production at all means difficulty to achieve self-fulfillment, but too much Productions may create too much pression, specially when the natal element is weak.

0 ANARCHISTIC PROD.

This kind of Productions is sometimes called "Anarchistic" or "Revolutionary", because they may be provocative or original. They symbolize artistic gifts, ambition and pride.

This aspect also controls the Power, but in a more aggressive way.

It is interesting only when the natal element is strong.

1 MAIN MONEY

Money comes from what we control.

This aspect, often related to a lot of efforts, indicates that there are possibilities to earn money.

But, for that, the natal element must be strong enough.

This aspect also symbolizes projects and plans, investments and sometimes spirit of adventure...

2 SECONDARY MONEY

This kind of money often indicates money easily earned (inheritance, gambling gains) or even illicitly earned.

3 MAIN POWER

Symbol of dignity, austerity, discipline and loyalty.

A chart without such an aspect may indicate a dull person, or a dull life. Or difficulty to succeed... except during periods (decade, year...) having this aspect.

In a balanced chart, there must be Money to generate Power.

Anyway, too much Power is not good, even Main Power.

2 SECONDARY POWER

This kind of Power is associated with aggressiveness and exagerated ambition. Which often comes with courage, and self-discipline.



It's better if there is some Productions to control it (specially in an adjoining Pillar): in this case, Secondary Power reinforces the Main Power, if it exists.
 If there is no Productions, this aspect attacks the natal element, violently if this natal element is weak.

3 MAIN POTENTIAL

This aspect is related to the help coming from the family and from the superiors. It speaks of orderliness and of organization. It eases the constraints, specially those induced by Power. If this aspect is not present, this is often related with a lot of obstacles, but too much potential often means rigidity.

1 SECUNDARY POTENTIAL

This aspect is good at supporting the natal element, if this one needs support. But it must not be too present, it would otherwise attack the Productions.

0 REINFORCEMENT

This aspect helps to reinforce the natal element, specially if it is located in the month pillar, but it's useless if this element is already strong. It symbolizes patience, perseverance and realism.

3 DISSENSION

This aspect describes the rivals.
 Its meaning worsens if it is located in the Month Pillar or if the natal element is strong.

Notion of Clash between two Stems:

The Heavenly Stems clash in the following way:

- ? **Jia** and **Geng**.
- ? **Yi** and **Xin**.
- ? **Bing** and **Ren**.
- ? **Ding** and **Gui**.

Signs of Intelligence:

Student (humanities): you like reading (and writing), and, more generally, you like arts. This energy strengthens the other artistic predispositions. You enjoy talking, you feel at ease in an intellectual circle. You have a gift for studies.

Little Problems:

Spirit you are a good organizer. Your spouse may have judicial problems.



Signs of Protection:

Mandarin: this energy generally indicates a lot of intelligence. You inspire trust, and this leads you to the higher echelons. You like studies, you collect titles, degrees and books. It is often the sign of great success in every field. It is also a protective star that helps to overcome obstacles, and to avoid ordeals. However, if other negative energies intervene, success may be weakened: to be gifted is not always enough.

Peace: this energy of happiness and protection also indicates a propensity for spirituality, or even religion. You have understood that the main thing in life is to progress, to evolve.

Rating the Stems with the Branches...

There are different ways of comparing the Eight Words. One of them consists in evaluating the Stems in function of the Branches. This gives twelve possibilities, called the twelve energies of the Endless Cycle, or Longevity cycle.

They describe the twelve stages of the cycle of Time. They also symbolize the reincarnation cycle, i.e. the journey of the soul. Each step allows to measure the strength of a Stem relatively to a given Branch.

1. Evaluate and analyze the Stem of the Day Master relatively to the different branches.

Also called *Encounter* or **Fong**.

The analysis of the Day Master relatively to the Month Branch is called the Heavenly Condition.

Other analyses form the Earthly Condition.

The best case is when are present the maximum of energies like "Birth", "Youth", "Maturity", "Prosperity" et "Growth" .

And the minimum of "Adolescence", "Decline", "Sickness", "Death", "Burial", "Disappearance" and "Foetus" .

Decline: this energy of the endless circuit sometimes means a lack of vitality, discouragement, weariness.

Death indicates the end of a period. Some say it does not favor motherhood. This still has to be proved with serious statistics.

Foetus: often is a sign of a strong sexual appetite. It however favors all things linked to motherhood and reproduction. Indecisiveness, Naivety

Youth (also called *Hat & Belt*): this energy of the endless circuit may mean that you are courageous, well-groomed and smart. It also symbolizes the will to succeed.

Prosperity: a sign of expansion, of fertility, either for the family or for the fortune. Some keywords related to this energy: method, strategy, efficiency, travels, independance, influence...

Adolescence (or Bath or Puberty): this energy of the endless circuit is synonymous with sensual pleasure, with vanity. It may also mean a moody mind and restless wandering.

Growth or Nutrition: this energy of the endless circuit is associated with food, cooking, farming, and children too.

Birth or **Longevity**: this energy of the endless circuit usually is synonymous with duration, and particularly with a long life.

Disappearance (or Intransigence): some say that this energy of the endless circuit neither favors the longevity of the person nor his/her capacity to perpetuate himself/herself. This still has to be proved with serious statistics.

List of the Decades (Luck Periods)

"Ba Zi" Astrology divides the Life into 12 decades. Each of them is associated with a Pillar, i.e. a Heavenly Stem and a Earthly Branch, which can be compared with the Birth Day Pillar (Master Day): the result is a "climate" for this period.

The piece of information we must firstly examine is the Stem of the Luck Period (also called Great Passage or *Da Yun*). It may bring balance to the chart, or, on the contrary, be noxious. Some masters say that, inside a decade, during the 5 first years, the stem of the decade is more influent, but, after the 5th year, the branch influence regularly increases.

We must also examine the Stem and the Branch of the current year: see the analysis done by the button *Forecasts: analysis of a Date*.
